Welcome to **Johnny and the Dead!** It has been an absolute pleasure directing such a talented cast in this "fantastically funny" production.

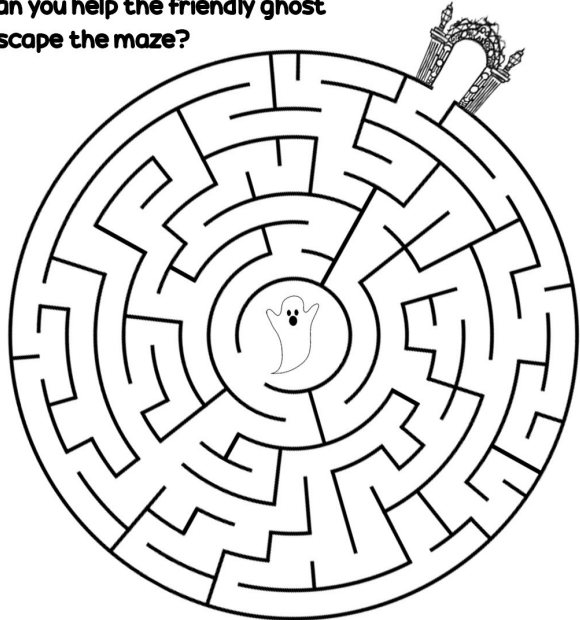
As soon as I picked up the script I knew this was my next play - so I went away and read the book to learn a little more about the character of Blackbury.
